

Primary Subject Leader Development Network

These network meetings aim to provide Maths Leaders with support to develop mathematics pedagogy and curriculum in their primary schools, together with development and guidance on leadership issues and skills. The meetings also offer the perfect opportunity for networking with colleagues and sharing best-practice ideas and resources.

Last year these meetings prioritised focus on developing teaching practice and curriculum resources. This year the meetings will continue to do this, but will now also offer additional focus on leadership support and strategies for coordinating Maths in school. As such, all meetings are underpinned by a three-fold structure of: pedagogy – leadership – networking.

The meetings are specifically targeted at Maths Subject Leaders or those with leadership responsibility that includes Maths (e.g. Phase Leaders).
