## NQT+ Programme 2018-2019

**Supporting our newer teachers to refine their practice, deepen their knowledge and engage in evidence based research. NQT+ delegates will benefit from sessions led by expert practitioners and continuing to develop a purposeful, focused peer network, enhanced by our Triad project.**

### **Core Sessions - half day afternoons**

This programme will be facilitated by a core delivery team of Lisa Vann (Programme Lead) and Rachel Meli who will lead sessions with guest facilitators. These senior practitioners include Specialist Leaders of Education (SLEs) or Outstanding Facilitators (OFPs). Facilitators will draw upon research and evidence to support NQT+ teachers throughout the year.

Sessions will involve small group discussion (strengthening peer networks), theory and practical ideas with a 'surgery' section with one of the delivery team to meet individual development needs.

Each session will be accompanied by resources on the Transform Google Drive and will allow dedicated time for reflection. NQT+ teachers will build a portfolio of learning over the year.

### **Sessions will consist of the following structure:**

- What does evidence tell us?
- What does this mean to us?
- What actions can we take?

Triads provide opportunity for NQT+ teachers to visit other schools. This will support collaboration across schools and enable everyone to share their Teaching and Learning reflections at our March session. This will be arranged in 2018/19 as a **lesson study format** with a focused Teaching and Learning enquiry question created by the Triad members.

### **NQT+ Coach support**

- NQT+ Coaches are invited to attend a meeting on 8th October from 4:00-5:00pm. Half- termly bulletins keep our coaches up to date with key themes explored.

### **New for 2018-2019**

- We will offer NQT+ Twilight sessions once each term to focus on bespoke support for key Curriculum areas of Maths, Reading and Writing.
