## NQT Programme 2018-2019

Providing NQTs with the opportunity to consolidate their learning with the support of scheduled CPD sessions, peer triads, and one-to-one coaching. These sessions give practical strategies, space for reflection and action planning with the benefit of networking with other NQTs and experienced practitioners to support teaching pedagogy and wellbeing.

### The core subjects addressed in the NQT Programme include:

- Classroom management
- Communication with other adults
- Adapting plans based on NQT feedback and issues relevant to schools
- Questioning
- Marking and feedback
- Career development
- Wellbeing
- Use of data

### Format

- A core delivery team of Lisa Vann, (Programme Lead) and Adele Thackeray will lead sessions with guest facilitators. These professionals are senior practitioners including Specialist Leaders of Education (SLEs) or Outstanding Facilitators (OFPs).
- Facilitators will draw upon research and evidence to support NQTs throughout the year.
- Sessions will enable small group discussion to develop a support network of peers, theory and practical ideas, plus a 1 hour **'surgery' section** with one of the delivery team to allow NQTs to meet individual development needs.
- Each session will be accompanied by resources on the Transform Google Drive.
- NQTs will build a portfolio of learning throughout the year and each session will have dedicated time for reflection built in.
- Peer triads provide opportunity for NQTs to visit other schools, supporting collaboration across schools, and then share their teaching and learning reflections at our session in March to capture best practice.

### NQT Mentor Support

- NQT Mentors are invited to attend a mentor meeting on 8th October from 4.00pm -5.00pm. Half termly bulletins keep our Mentors up to date with key themes explored.

### New for 2018-2019

- We are excited to offer our first **NQT Residential**. This will launch the year for our NQTs and help to establish a wide peer network from the beginning of the year. With teacher wellbeing as a key focus for our NQT Programme this launch will provide a rich opportunity to support our NQTs with workshops and teambuilding activities.
- We will also offer **NQT Twilight sessions** once each term to provide additional bespoke support for key curriculum areas of Maths, Reading and Writing.
