Leading and Developing the Creative Curriculum Development Days

The aim of the Creative Curriculum Development Days is to support teachers to design creative and exciting learning opportunities whilst building confidence and skills in leading a non-core subject throughout their schools. These sessions will provide practical ideas and resources for developing pupils skills across year groups in monitoring and assessing these to raise standards.

Workshops are planned with facilitators and subject SLEs looking at the following subject areas:

- Science

 - Technology
 - Humanities
 - Art & Design

We are encouraging schools to support their staff to access sessions related to their own areas of responsibility and to then share their learning across the whole school via staff meetings and INSET sessions.

iClassrooms (Open Classrooms)

Adopting digital technology to support curriculum delivery features heavily in this programme exploring how iPads and core apps can positively impact pupil achievement.

iClassrooms are a great opportunity to see first-hand an Apple Teacher using one of the Apple core apps to enhance the learning in their classroom. There will be an opportunity for a pre-lesson discussion to outline the focus for the session and post-observation discussion where delegates will explore how they can utilize the app in order to improve their own practice. Digital TeachMeets are an informal gathering for those curious about using iPads to support teaching and learning in the classroom. The aim is to share great ideas no matter how big or small around the use of different Apps to enhance the learning of our pupils.
