Charlotte has successfully completed the National Award for SENCOs (MA), where she has developed a deeper understanding of SEND, how children with different SEND learn, how provision should be matched to individual needs and how it should be reviewed. Following this, she successfully implemented provision management across the school which has had significant impact upon children’s progress. She has also been involved in tribunal cases.

She has led projects in schools which have focused upon raising standards in achievement for children with SEND through implanting new whole school initiatives e.g. Multisensory Literacy. This has had phenomenal results – one child made 13 months of progress in his spelling over a six week period.
